Banns of marriage between William Holt of this parish and Martha Wade of the parish of Boston were published on three Sundays, viz, August 7th, 14th and 21st and married on the 27th Day of August 1789

Richard Dawson Starke of the parish of Wigglesworth and Betty Hardacre of this parish were married by Licence the 24th Day of August 1789

John Boothman and Mary Ellen both of this parish were published on the three Sundays, viz, August 21st, 28th and 4th Sept. 6th and married on the 27th Day of Sept^{br} 1789

William Jackson of Helliwell and Ann Newell of this Parish were married in this Church by Licence the 27th Day of Dec^{br} 1789

William Lockshott of this parish and Margaret Foster of the Parish of Storton were married in this Church by Licence the 24th Day of Jan^{ry} 1790
