His wife Jane Chippendale Nee Morphet Morphet died in February 1889 and her daughter by her first marriage Mary Alice Metcalfe had Married George Wigglesworth who lived opposite the Elm Tree Inn in Embsay at Mattock's Shop as an Apprentice Grocer. This shop is currently the Post Office. William Turpin Chippendale was often known only as Turpin Chippendale and there was a consensus in the Wigglesworth family that Turpin Chippendale had gambled away what remained of his wifes money she had brought to the marriage. On Turpins death in 1898 reputedly the money loaned to Turpin was called in by the Chippendale family and Turpins step-daughter and Mary Alice who moved to 31/33 Newmarket Street, Skipton with her husband and family were running a grocery business. To pay off her fathers debts it is said she had to sell her wedding ring which and was left penniless and the Elm Tree Inn was taken over by Willim Maude in 1900.
