LONG PRESTON

- D95. Sacred/ to the Memory of/ Mary Jane infant daughter of/ William & Grace IRVING of/ Long Preston who died June 4th 1837/ also of Aitchison their sixth son/ who departed this life March 4th/ 1850 aged 17 years/ likewise of David Alexander/ the fifth son who died October 26th/ 1850 aged 21 years/ also William father of the above/ named children/ who died Decr. 4th/ 1856 aged 71 years/ also Grace relict of William IRVING/ and mother of the above named/ children who died January 22nd 1869/ aged 73 years.
- D96. In/ Memoriam/ Agnes wife of George DELVES/ of Long Preston/ died 13th November 1883/ aged 60 years/ also of the above George DELVES/ who died June 1st 1886/ aged 68 years.
- D97. "Them also/ which sleep in Jesus/ will God bring with him"/ Here sleeps/ Colonel George William HORTON/ who died at Embay Kirk May 1st 1877/ aged 84 years/ He served with the 71st/ Highland Light Infantry/ in the Peninsular & Waterloo Campaigns/ under the Duke of Wellington/ here resteth/ Frances Esther wife of Colonel HORTON/ of Embay Kirk/ in this county which deceased March 23rd 1861.
- D98. "Suffer little/ children to come unto/ me and forbid them not for/ such is the Kingdom of God" Luke XVIII 16/ Harriett Mary/ HORTON oldest/ daughter of Col./ HORTON died at/ Halton Place/ Sepr. 20th 1841/ aged 12 years/ Elizabeth Fanny/ HORTON second/ daughter of Col./ HORTON died at/ Halton Place/ April 25th 1841/ aged 7 years/ "Lovely and pleasant were they/ in their lives and in their deaths/ they were not divided" 2 Sam. 1 23/ also Henry third son of Col. HORTON/ who died February 7th 1844 aged 4 years/ and Arthur Henry fourth son of Col. HORTON/ died April 15th 1850 aged 2 years and a half.
