Memorandum made this 20th day of August
1815 Between Mr. Rob^t Burnside and Mr. Speeding
B^y. He said Mr. Speeding is to pay all the Rates
Taxes and every other imposition for and in respect of the House
Numbers 4 in Robin Hood Lane purchased by the said
Robert Burnside up to 1st Mich^{as} next and it is also
agreed between the said parties that 20 part of the
purchase money shall be retained by the said Robert
Burnside until a Fine is levied, and the Will and Probate
of William Speeding the Father of the said James Speeding
is registered at the Register Office for the County of Middlesex
and also until ^{a copy of the} Abstract, an attested Copy of the same
to the said Mr. Speeding and an attested Copy of the Deed of
Covenant from Samuel Hanbury Esquire to the said William
Speeding is delivered to the said Robert Burnside free of expense
to ^{him} the said Robert Burnside
