 hereunto annexed purporting to be the last will & Testament of the said

 subscribed Coblack and having the following Deturbations written at
 the bottom of the said will to wit the words or the substance of them or the
 substance of such Deturbations written between the seventh & eighth lines of
 the first sheet of the said will beginning from the top thereof the word
 same" interlined between the twenty fourth & twenty fifth lines of the said
 sheet beginning as aforesaid also having the words her Executors aditors or
 assigns interlined between the second & third lines of the second sheet of the said
 will beginning as aforesaid also having the words but in case she should
 happen to die before my wife then the said Sum of three hundred pounds
 between the fifth & sixth lines of the said sheet beginning as aforesaid
 also having the words after my said wife's decease interlined between
 the fourth & fifth lines of the said sheet beginning as aforesaid also
 having the words within six months after my wife's decease interlined
 between the twenty fourth & twenty fifth lines of the said sheet beginning
 as aforesaid that these Depositions do verify & in things concerning herein the
 said will & Testament of the said will were made at the request of
 now in the same plight & condition as when the same was made by
 the said & in the presence of the said Depositions that Field of Curtes

not as joint tenants and to their several respective Executors, Administrators & Assigns - absolutely for ever and I do hereby nominate & appoint my said brother John Perkins Thomas & my much beloved friend George Field Harris of the town of Plymouth, Dorset aforesaid Gentleman Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking & making void all former & other wills and wills by me at any time or times heretofore made & do declare this to be & contain my last will & testament and do hereby declare it to be my will that my said Executors & the Survivors of them his Executors & assigns shall not be as to a responsible or accountable for more of my personal Estate & Testamentary Estate and Effort than they or any or either of them shall respectively actually receive or shall come to their respective hands by virtue of this my will nor with or for any loss which may happen of the same or any part thereof or as such loss happen without their or one of their wilful neglect or default - nor the one of them my said Executors for the other of them or for their acts or omissions or omissions payments neglect or default Executors or Administrators of the other of them but each of them for himself only and also that it shall and may be lawful to & for my said Executors & the Survivors of them Executors and Administrators upon all occasions in the first place by and out of my said Estate & Effort or the monies arising therefrom to deduct & retain to & reimburse himself & themselves respectively all such Costs Charges Damages Demands & Expenses whatsoever as they shall respectively sustain or be put into in or about the execution of this my will or in any thing in any wise relating thereto or concerning the same In witness whereof I the said Copartners Thomas the Testator have to this my last will & testament written on four sheets of paper out my hand and Seal to wit my hand only at the bottom of the four first sheets thereof & my hand and Seal to this fifth & last sheet thereof this twenty ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty two Cop. Thomas L. Esq. signed sealed published & declared by the said Copartners Thomas the Testator as & for his last will & testament in the presence of us who at his request in his presence & in the presence of each other did our oaths subscribe our names as witnesses Geo. F. Harris Esq. Conveyancer Plymouth Dorset J. W. Sheppard - his Clerk
