this twenty seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine - Thomas Perkins Thomas - signed by him as said testator as his last will and Testament in the presence of us present at the same time who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses - J. P. Guizelle ex - Clerk. (Newport) Devonport Workhouse, Lord Devonport.

Proved at London 9th Jan^y. 1873 by the Oath of Thomas Thomas and his wife John Thomas Clerk the said and Eleanor Clissarozou widow his daughter the co-executors to whom power was granted.
