

Thomas Perkins THOMAS Will

I Thomas Perkins Thomas of 60 Cobourg Street Plymouth declare this to be my last will and testament. And do hereby give unto my dear children Thomas Thomas, John Thomas and Eleanor Richardson the whole of my real and personal estate whatever and wheresoever to hold unto them their heirs executors and administrators to be divided equally between my said three children in such way as they may respectively and collectively agree and I hereby appoint my aforesaid three children the Executors and Executrix of this my will at the same time revoking all former and other wills whatsoever by me at any time hereinbefore made.

In witness whereof I have herewith set my hand this twenty seventh day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine

- Thomas Perkins Thomas – Signed by the said testator as his last will and testament in the presence of us present at the same time who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses – J P Gruzelier, Elizabeth Ann Gruzelier; Devonport, Workhouse Ford, Devonport

At London 9th Jan 1873 By the oaths of Thomas Thomas and The Reverend John Thomas his sons and Eleanor Richardson Widow his daughter, the executors to whom administration was granted
