On the 1 August 2001 the RSC adopted a new set of By-laws following the Extraordinary General Meeting vote on 16 November 2000. The changes will broaden the membership base of the RSC to enable a wider range of people with a qualification in the chemical sciences to be admitted. Membership categories have been simplified and the award of CChem is now separated from admission to a category of membership.

I am writing to confirm that your category of membership is affected by the changes, as set out in the earlier briefing documents. As you have been an Associate Member of the RSC for more than 3 years, **from 1 August you moved into the category of Member of the Royal Society of Chemistry.** You are now entitled to use the designatory letters MRSC, and communications from the RSC will reflect this change over the coming months. I am pleased to enclose your new membership certificate.

The membership category change will also result in an adjustment, phased in over four years, in the annual subscriptions of members, other than Retired or Life Members, to bring them into line with others in this category.

Later in the year we will send you the 2001 edition of *the Members' Handbook*, and a new *Code of Conduct and Guidance on Professional Practice with your Chemistry in Britain*; both of which will reflect the changes to the RSC membership structure. You will also receive the RSC's framework for Continuing Professional Development.
